Professor Pages: Easy Course Website Maintenance

Abstract

Website builder applications are gaining its importance not only among business professional but also among teachers and professors. The motivation of this thesis is to develop an application which allows the teachers and professors to create a classroom website in few minutes without any prior knowledge of HTML and web designing. It also allows them to edit the content of the website. One of the significant feature of this application is it allows the user to create new pages in website which can have just plain text or list of links or both which is not available in many of the similar kind of applications on the internet. Plain text is handled through a WYSIWYG HTML editor which works like a Microsoft word.
